By joining ROSIM, you maintain a strong bond with fellow ministers and benefit from a platform to share your insights, thoughts, and experiences.

Membership in ROSIM includes numerous benefits, including the creation of a personal minister profile on our website, increasing your visibility to those in search of your specialised services. OneSpirit Board of Trustees

OneSpirit is continuously seeking passionate individuals to join our board. Trustees work with the leadership team to set objectives and ensure our charitable purpose is fulfilled. We aim to enhance our board's diversity and capacity, valuing relationship-building and leadership skills from all backgrounds. Trustees undergo a six-month attunement period before being appointed for a four-year term. This unpaid role includes reimbursements for reasonable expenses, with meetings held quarterly via Zoom.

OneSpirit Ethics & Standards Committee:

The Ethics & Standards Committee advises on professional standards and ethical issues within our ministerial community. This minister-led committee, maintaining a degree of separation from the foundation, will draft their terms of reference, review the existing Code of Ethics, and evaluate membership requirements, possibly developing a Code of Practice. This initiative seeks to maintain high ethical standards and transparency within our community.

iConnect Newsletter:

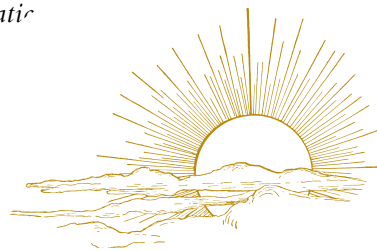

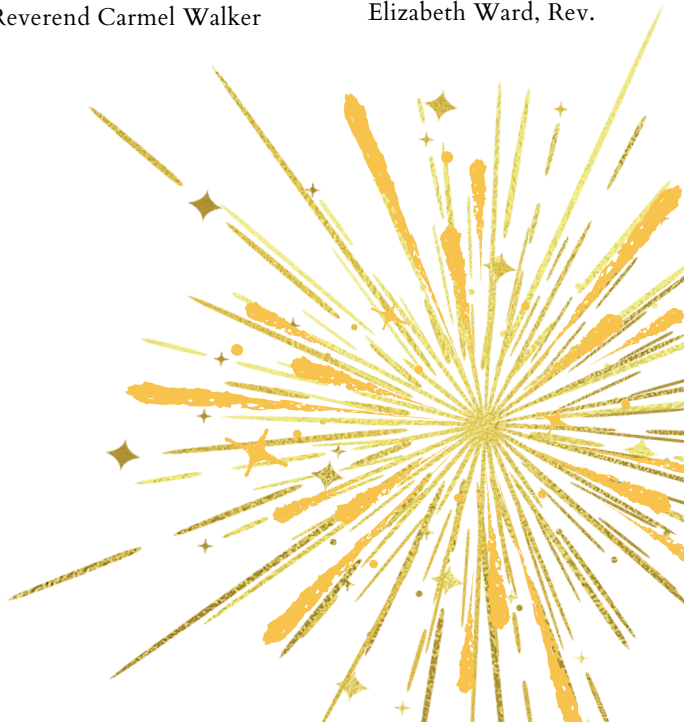
