


Position Overview: Nominator for the Register of Approved Celebrants in Scotland

- Must be a OneSpirit Interfaith Foundation Minister with two to three years of experience conducting legal weddings in Scotland.
- Must reside in Scotland and meet the required criteria for holding legal weddings.

Overview

• This Role is appointed by OneSpirit to act as a local point of contact and signatory in the process of granting OneSpirit Ministers permission to hold a legal wedding.

Nominator's Responsibilities

- 1. To be the nominated person in Scotland who supports applications for OneSpirit Ministers to hold their first legal wedding.
- 2. Liaise with OneSpirit staff to confirm that Ministers have completed the required processes for authorisation.
- 3. Have an in-depth knowledge of the legislation surrounding marriage in Scotland, (current and emerging) and the interpretation and application relevant to OneSpirit Ministers.
- 4. Be a point of contact and support for Ministers in Scotland with regards to legal marriage.
- 5. Be a point of contact for the National Records of Scotland.
- 6. Keep OneSpirit updated in relation to any changes in legislation or practice in Scotland and inform the minister body accordingly.
- 7. Liaise with OneSpirit staff to continue to develop good practices in relation to Minister accountability, reporting, development and support.
- 8. Liaise with Scotland Legal Wedding Training Lead and participate in CPD relevant to legal marriage and wider ministry.
- 9. Liaise with OneSpirit staff in encouraging Ministers to engage in community in relation to legal marriage, and their wider ministry, to develop supportive networks.
- 10. Work with OneSpirit and other nominators to ensure consistency in approaches across all registers supported by OneSpirit.
- 11. To be the final signatory on the letter requesting a OneSpirit Minister be added to the register.

Nominator Specification

- 1. A OneSpirit Interfaith Foundation Minister with two or three years experience of in holding legal weddings in Scotland.
- 2. Resident in Scotland and meets the required criteria for holding legal weddings.
- 3. A developed capacity to communicate the responsibilities that ministers who are holding legal weddings have to their client, the Registrar General and OneSpirit.
- 4. A good understanding of the legal and ethical requirements placed on a nominating organisation.
- 5. Desire to support ministers with the legal and ethical requirements to ensure the criteria of the process are met and honourably upheld.
- 6. Desire to support Ministers and develop supportive networks.
- 7. Experience working in a diverse team and working to an agreed plan.
- 8. Experience in successfully managing complex projects, and a track record of commitment to service.
- 9. Ability to work with technology and use the different systems and processes that support OneSpirit's administration process.
- 10. Good broadband access for e-mail, Slack and Zoom communications.
